### 1. Gazetteers.

These are used to find place-names and information about the place: parishes, villages, chapelries, & hamlets in the area under the jurisdiction. The name of the registration district for civil registration. Whether it is a parish or not. Also, name of non-conformist churches in the area.

### 2. Maps.

Ordnance survey maps.

Parish maps. "Atlas & Index of Parish Registers"

Street maps.

Topographical survey's.

### 3. Directories:

Street directories, Kelly's directories, Dwelly's

directories, Pigot's directories, etc.

#### 4. Place-name publications.

The lesser known houses, seats, localities, along with the names of the more prominent place names, hamlets, villages, towns, and parishes are often covered, along with many other places usually known only by local residents.
