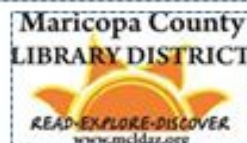
Genealogy Connect service allows users to perform simple and advanced searches through all content or within a specific title.

GET STARTED

- 1. Start with the family information you know.**
Fill out a pedigree chart. Try the link below for a free copy
http://www.comportone.com/cpo/genealogy/images/pedigree_chartz.gif
- 2. Decide what information is needed.**
Look at the information that is missing and determine which one bit of information is needed.
- 3. Select a record type to search.**
If a relative's birth date and place is needed, then search for birth certificates. A marriage license will provide the marriage date and place.
- 4. Obtain the record and identify the information needed.**
Records may need to be obtained online, by mail, email, on microfilm or in person.
- 5. Record and evaluate the information once it is found.**
Evaluate if the information is accurate and reliable, will it lead to more research or will it lead to a dead end.
