RootsMagic

Before you start, go to FamilySearch and find the ID number of the person’s tree you wish to import.

1. Download - RootsMagic Essentials – Free Version at <https://www.rootsmagic.com>
2. Click on “Create a new file”. Enter a file name, select a date form – day, month, year is recommended
3. Click on the dropdown box under “Number to display after name” and select “FamilySearch ID”
4. Check the box that says “LDS support” and “FamilySearch Family Tree Support”
5. Click on “Import information from another program”. If you have a **CURRENT** GEDCOM or PAF file, you can select to import from that. IF NOT...
6. Close the box and then go to the “File” dropdown tab and select “FamilySearch Central”.
7. In the next pop-up box, click on “Import”.
8. You then have option to select “import to be Me” or “The FamilySearch person with this ID”. This is where you will enter the Family Search ID of the person’s tree you want imported. You can begin with yourself or any ancestor.
9. Roots Magic automatically selects “4” generations, etc. to import; select the number of “Ancestors” and “Descendants” you want imported, then click Import.
10. Depending on the number of ancestors you import, this process may take a while. (Possibly overnight)
11. Once file is imported, you can create a GEDCOM file by:
 - Going to the “File” tab and click on “Export”.
 - Pop-up box will allow you to name the file and where you want it saved. Be sure it is saved as a GEDCOM file.

Sign in to Ancestry, click on the “Family Trees” dropdown box. Select “Upload a GEDCOM”. Select your RootsMagic file from your computer to upload and click the “I accept the Submission Agreement” box, then click “Upload”. **Note:** You will want to repeat this procedure for your spouse.
