

How to Copy Digital Book URLs

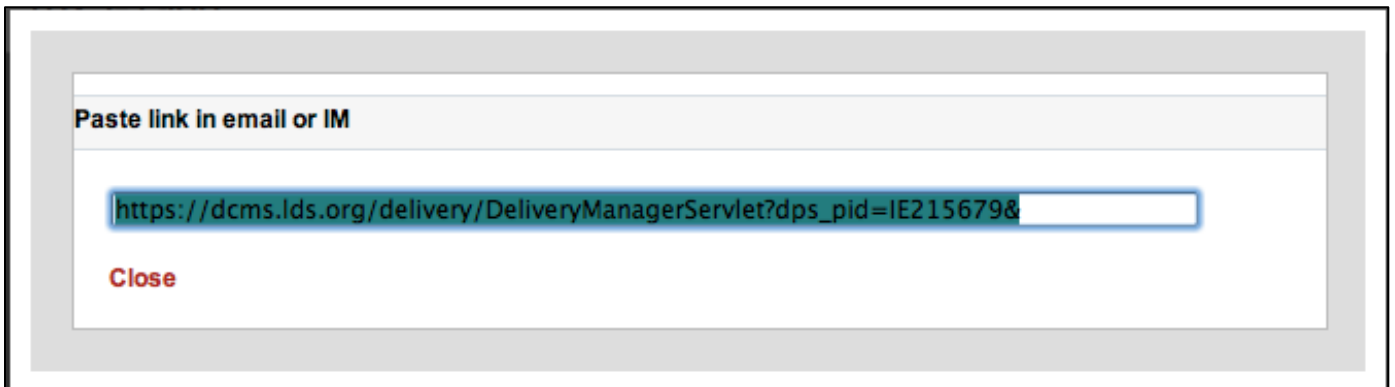
1. The book, "The Journal of Lorenzo Brown, 1823-1900," is in the Mesa Book Catalog and shows there is a link to a digital version as seen here:

2. To access the digital version, click on "Details" and scroll to the bottom of the page where the link is underlined in blue.
3. Click on the link. Images from the book appear. To save this link, DO NOT COPY THE ONE AT THE TOP OF THE PAGE. This is NOT necessarily a permanent link. Instead, move the arrow to the upper right corner where this sign is located:



4. Hover over it with the arrow and the following words will appear: "click to share." Click once and the following will appear:



5. This is the permanent link. To copy it, hold down the Control key and the "C" key at the same time. (For Apple computers, hold down the Command key and the "C" key). To paste it, go to the document, email, or wherever it is to be stored. Click once where it is to be pasted. Hold down the Control Key and the "V" key at the same time, and it will paste in. (For Apple computers, hold down the Command key and the "V" key).
6. Click on the red "Close" as seen above to return to the digital book.

This procedure for preserving links also applies to links found in the FamilySearch Catalog.
